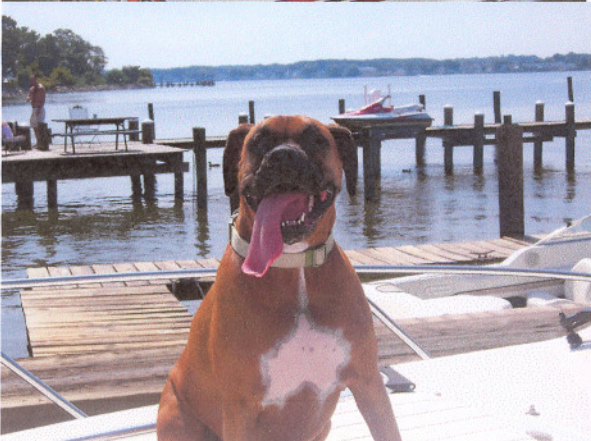
A gathering of Cormorants
